Background information: The Heritage Rooms were previously leased to North Kesteven District Council to operate as a specialised community centre for "local heritage purposes" including "practical activities, exhibitions and exhibition workshops" on a not for profit basis. This lease ran from 1993 to 2018. The Heritage Rooms reverted to the Charity on expiry of the lease. The proposed change to the "purpose" of the Heritage Rooms as set out above is intended to reflect the expiry of that lease but also the continuation of such artistic, craft and cultural activities at the premises. The proposed new purpose above is consistent with formal written advice provided by the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

The proposed change will have no impact upon the separate charitable purpose of the adjacent chapel of ease, which will remain unchanged.
