Amendment of the Garrett's Charity Scheme, January 2025

Further to the Public Notice of 6th January 2025 and subject to the final approval of the Charity Commission for England and Wales the proposed change to the purpose of the Heritage Rooms would amend the use of property clause in the charity Scheme as follows:

26. <u>Use of property</u>. Subject as herein otherwise provided, the Managing Trustees shall appropriate and use the said lands with buildings thereon specified in the said schedule as follows:

The land numbered 1, for the purpose of furthering the religious, educational and other charitable work of the Church of England in the area of benefit.

The land numbered 2, for the for the benefit of the residents of the area of benefit and the neighbourhood, without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political, religious or other opinions by associating together the said residents and the local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation including artistic, craft and cultural activities with the objective of improving the conditions of life for the residents.

SCHEDULE

The following adjoining lands situate at Heighington in the County of Lincolnshire:

- 1. Land containing 125.42 square metres or thereabouts with the building thereon known as the Chapel of Ease.
- 2. Land containing 1505 square metres or thereabouts with the building thereon known as the former Heighington School and playground.
