Now that the new swings are in at Station Road, it would be nice to finish that area off with a new bench and bin. (The exact location would need to be determined, taking into account a safety area around the swings and other equipment).

The parish council would have to mow the grass around this equipment (as we currently do around the play area fencing) as the contractor's mower will not be able to get close.

### **Bin options**

Supplier: Glasdon



This matches the type currently installed near the beck.

Price £163.97 exc VAT

We would have to confirm with NKDC that they would be willing to empty an additional bin at Station Road.

### **Installation**

We believe the installation could be facilitated by our Caretaker/Handyperson in conjunction with the local handyman we use, so there would be an additional cost for this. (We already have slabs that could be used for the base).

### **Funding**

We currently have £494.04 of CiL<sup>1</sup> funds that could be used for these purchases. We have money left in various budget heads in this year, that could be used for the remainder of the expenditure. (For example, Station Road open space budget).

### **Recommendation**

That the council considers the purchase of a new bench and/or bin for Station Road, the exact location (in the vicinity of the new swings) to be determined, and for these to be funded from CiL and other budgets, as above.
